

< Preparing Your Space For A 3D Tour >

To ensure your 3D Tour is delivered to the highest quality please read the checklist below.



1. CLEAN UP

The optimum method to showcase your space is achieved by presenting your furniture, floorboards and fixtures as you would present them for an open inspection/event.



2. ITEMS TO BE REMOVED

- » Washing & washing baskets
- » Magnets, notices & other paperwork removed from the fridge
- » Dishes
- » Toys
- » Shoes
- » Magazines
- » TV remotes
- » Valuables or personal items
- » Toiletries & shower products
- » Close toilet seats
- » Pets/animals removed or kept out of sight
- » Vehicles removed from carport or front lawn
- » Waste bins out of sight for the external 360° scans
- » General clutter - don't just hide items (e.g. behind couches) as they will still appear in the tour, instead place these items in closed cupboards or spaces

These objects add unnecessary clutter to your space, which is reflected in your 3D Tour. If you prefer for a certain room to not be scanned, please advise your 3D Technician.

3. OVERALL PRESENTATION

Please ensure the list below is completed prior to scanning for optimum marketing results.

- » House has been cleaned & tidied
- » Lights and lamps on
- » Curtains and blinds open
- » Outdoor areas presentable
- » All internal doors open
- » First impressions last - stage your home to appeal to potential buyers.

We recommend walking around your property and pausing where people are likely to stop. What will they see? How will this affect how they view the rest of the home? If these areas are not pleasing to the eye they may need your extra attention.



4. STAY OUT OF FRAME

Please remember the camera rotates 360 degrees unlike traditional cameras. If there are small children present, please ensure they are supervised during the scan. It is crucial that you inform the 3D Technician immediately if anyone has walked past the camera. Images cannot be deleted or edited once the 3D Technician has left your space.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

// HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO CAPTURE AND CREATE A 3D TOUR?

It takes approx. 2 hours to scan a space (depending on the size). Once completed, the content is uploaded to the cloud and processed, with the 3D Tour back to you within 24 hours.

// HOW CAN I SHARE A 3D TOUR?

We provide a simple link that is easily implemented onto any website and is easily shared via web and mobile. 3D Tours can be accessed from anywhere in the world, at any given time.

// WHAT KIND OF AWESOME TECHNOLOGY IS USED?

The camera uses a combination of infrared and photogrammetry in order to build a 3D Tour of any space.
